The IAG-RCG 2020 Conference will include a 4-day field trip to visit scenic and remarkable desert landforms of Iran such as sand dunes, playa lakes and yardangs. The field trip may be extended 1 or 2 days. During the excursion, we will arrange 2-nights' accommodation in a Caravanserai, which is an outstanding and comfortable desert lodging. FIELD TRAINING SCHOOL ON "DESERT GEOMORPHOLOGY"

As part of the Conference program, the IAG Intensive Course for Young Geomorphologists will be held from 29 October to 1 November 2020 at Ferdowsi University of Mashhad (FUM) and field trip places.

 The registration fee of the conference includes lunches and dinners during the conference, visiting Tomb of Ferdowsi, conference package (including proceedings book, and souvenirs of Iran), Social dinner, and 4-nights' accommodation.

E-Visa

- The Electronic Visa (E-Visa) can be issued at the Mashhad International Airport upon arrival with the coordination of Ferdowsi University of Mashhad. Delegates will receive a Visa grant notice in advance.
- There is no difference between electronic and normal Visas in terms of duration.
- The new E-Visa provides foreigners the chance to visit Iran without any concern. With the E-Visa, passports of travelers entering Iran will not be stamped as the Visa is issued on a separate piece of paper.
- We will provide ahead of time all relevant information to apply for your E-Visa, which should be done through the following website (https://evisatraveller.mfa.ir/en/request/).
