

Annual report on the activities of the IAG-WG on “Connectivity in Geomorphology” (2019-2020)

1. Book project

Ronald Pöpl, Anthony Parsons (i.e. the leaders of this WG) and Saskia Keesstra have signed a contract with Cambridge University Press to produce an edited book entitled “Connectivity in Geomorphology” which will be published in 2022. In this book, various aspects of geomorphic connectivity research will be covered by a set of renowned international connectivity scientists. The IAG-WG will also be mentioned in the foreword of this book.

2. EGU 2020

On the 6th of May 2020, the WG organized an IAG-co-sponsored session entitled “(Dis)connectivity in hydro-geomorphic systems: emerging concepts and their applications” (<https://meetingorganizer.copernicus.org/EGU2020/session/37501>) with ca. 75 online participants.

3. Online discussions: “Connectivity Conversations”

Due to the success of the WG’s EGU session (see 2), the WG decided to offer online discussions on a more regular basis. These online meetings will be called “Connectivity Conversations” in which short keynote talks should lead to vital online discussions in chat format. The first Connectivity Conversations will take place on the 15th of October 2020.
