Meeting summary report

Welcome of meeting participants

Francesca Vergari and Manel Llena opened the meeting and welcomed all meeting participants. In total 61 participants from more than 15 different countries participated in the meeting. The meeting agenda was presented and approved.

9th Badlands WG Webinar

Intervention of the speakers was convened thanks to the valuable collaboration of Nevena Antic (Serbia) and Aydogan Avcioglu (Turkey). The webinar included three scientific talks from BADLANDS WG members and provided an overview of latest research outcomes on badlands presented by members of the group. First, Milica Kašanin-Grubin (University of Belgrade, Serbia) gave a keynote talk of around 30 minutes about the differences, changes and opportunities of the different material composing badlands around the world.

After the keynote, two interesting presentations of 15 minutes each were given by George Olivier (Stellenbosch University, South Africa) and Cyrille Fauchard (Cerema, France), respectively. George Olivier presented the historical evolution of gullies in South Africa, relating this with the

changes in climate and land use, while Cyrille Fauchard showed the main results of a study of coastal badlands supported by geophysical imaging.

It is worth mentioning that all the talks were well attended and received, prove of that was the multiple questions and intervention of the webinar's assistants, as well as some discussion at the end of the last presentation.
