

Tectonic Geomorphology Working Group

Past activities:

- As previously announced in the 2023 report, the Tectonic Geomorphology Working Group organized a session on "Seismic and Tectonic Geomorphology" during the IAG Regional Conference on Geomorphology, held in Cappadocia, Turkey, from 12 to 14 September 2023. During the session, 8 oral and 8 poster presentations were delivered.
- Furthermore, the Working Group has completed a series of online webinars featuring experts from Italy, Greece, Germany, Turkey, and New Zealand, presenting on diverse topics associated with Tectonic Geomorphology. The inaugural presentation was delivered on 2 March 2023 by Dr. Emmanuel Vassilakis from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, as part of the activities of the International Geomorphology Week of the IAG, attracting 67 attendees. The remaining webinars were delivered between April 2023 and July 2023 by Dr. Julius Jara-Muñoz, Dr. Cengiz Yildirim, Dr. Marta Della Seta, Dr. Michele Delchiaro, and Dr. Jonathan Griffin.

Since September 2023, the Working Group has admitted two new members from Israel and India.
